This unique rainforest, hidden within the crater of a massive volcano, is located over 2,500 meters above sea level. Its remote and challenging location has made it nearly impossible to access, even for the local people who live on the slopes of Mount Bosavi.

In 2009 CE, an international team of scientists explored this hidden ecosystem and uncovered an extraordinary array of plants and animals. Among **their** discoveries were brightly colored, tiny frogs; unusual species of fish; rare bats and spiders; a kangaroo resembling a small bear; and a giant rat the size of a cat. This remarkable rainforest provides a glimpse into a world that has remained untouched for centuries.
