- **D. I'll celebrate.** الشرح: الجملة تعبر عن حدث مستقبلي ممكن حدوثه بناءً على شرط اجتياز الامتحان. "I'll celebrate" هو رد فعل طبيعي عند النجاح، مثل الاحتفال.

If you have a party, \_\_\_\_\_

- **A. we'll bring the juice.** الشرح: الشرط هنا هو إقامة حفلة، والرد يتضمن فعلاً سيحدث كنتيجة لهذا الحدث، مثل إحضار العصير.

If I lose my bag, \_\_\_\_\_

- **C. I'll be quite angry.** الشرح: فقدان الحقيبة سيؤدي غالباً إلى رد فعل عاطفي مثل الغضب، لذلك "I'll be quite angry" هو الرد المنطقي.
